


Ammon Cemetery Regulations

1. The planting of any type of tree or shrub within the cemetery is prohibited, roses included. The Cemetery will remove and discard all unauthorized plantings without notice.
2. The planting of flowers is limited to planters at the sides only of the headstone foundation and must be bordered by at least 4 inches of concrete flush with the ground. Border blocks are not permitted and will be removed and discarded. No plantings of any kind will be permitted on the front or back side of any base.
3. Metal hanging brackets or “shepherd hooks” must be installed in the foundation at least 4 inches from the edge or sides in such a manner as to not interfere with mowing, trimming or the passing of equipment between markers. Anything left on the grave or monument closer than 4 inches to any edge of grass will be removed and discarded without notice. The time between the Friday before Memorial day to the Monday following Memorial day will be excepted.



4. No marker or monument foundation wider than 24 inches will be permitted. A minimum of 4 inches of the foundation must be exposed all around the marker or monument.
5. Any type of marker or monument not in line with the headstones must be flush with the ground to allow mowers and other equipment to pass

over it without damage to the equipment. They must also be reinforced enough to withstand being passed over with loaded vehicles as is sometimes necessary in the course of normal cemetery activities. The Cemetery will not be responsible for damage to secondary markers because of poor support of the marker.

6. All foundations must be flush with the ground except where this is impossible as on a steep hillside.
7. Please no glass or ceramic containers for cleanliness and safety.
8. Watering is by automatic sprinklers and is subject to start at any time day or night.
9. No grave site will be opened without being paid for in advance, including opening and closing fees unless being paid through a local funeral home.
10. The Cemetery will not be liable for any damage to any plant because of normal spraying activities.
11. Residence of the cemetery taxing district may purchase 4 plots at in district price all other over and above that amount will be at out of district pricing. Maximum of 10 Burial plots without board approval. Except in Div 3 where 10 may be purchased at in District price.
